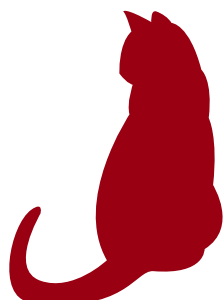

Upon adoption all felines are current on age appropriate core vaccinations, deworming, nail trim and monthly preventative. FVRCP should be administered every four weeks until 16 weeks of age. FeLV requires two doses administered four weeks apart. Rabies, FVRCP, and FeLV are due one year after they are administered as kittens. The next round is due after three years. Spay/neuter should be performed at four-five months. If adopters choose to perform spay/neuter through Foster2Forever, it will be done at a discounted rate, and all age-appropriate vaccinations will be provided during the surgery. Prices may be changed at any time without notice. Foster2Forever's veterinary partners reserve the right to change their pricing at any time without notice.
